

Starting at 2:00 PM, Coaches can check in to pick up their team packets, which will include event schedules, tournament programs, team tee shirts, other tournament information, team pit passes and event wrist-bands. Team members will not be permitted into the pit area or any other “Team Only” area without their team lanyards. Team members must also wear their event wristbands in order to be admitted to any of the special events (National Museum of the United States Air Force event and the Friday and Saturday team dinners).

At this time, coaches will pick up the deluxe box lunches for his/her team. Food may be consumed in the Pit Area. You must be done with your meal before you board the buses to the Museum.

2:00 PM – 3:30 PM: Team members, coaches and family members are invited into the pit area in order to set up their area (this is the only time family is permitted in the Pit). We recommend that you bring displays that illustrate your state and the unique qualities of your team. Your pit area will consist of one, 3 foot by 6 foot table and 8 folding

chairs. Plan for a 10 foot by 10 foot area as your team space. Your table will have access to electricity; however, if you want a surge protector, you must supply your own.
