Competition Rounds
9:00 AM

Pits open at 8:00 AM. All teams will be in the Pit at the same time. On this day, teams will share their practice table with five (5) other teams, two (2) of whom will be their alliance partners. It is up to the six (6) teams who share a practice table to decide on practice table scheduling. This is a problem-solving, teamwork task – please remember your Gracious Professionalism!



Competition Rounds will begin at 9:00 AM. There will be four (4) full competition sets (eight (8) half tables); two (2) competition sets will run competitions every five (5) minutes.

There will be a fifteen (15) minute break between Rounds One and Two; there will be a lunch break after Round Two from 11:45 AM to 12:45 PM. Competition Rounds will end at 2:00 PM.

The Robot Performance Award will be the best score out of these three official competition rounds. This high score will also be used to determine Champion's Award rankings.

Elimination Rounds
2:15 PM

The eight teams with the highest scores from the official competition rounds will compete in elimination matches. The team that wins the Elimination Round will win an

optional award: The Robot Elimination Award. This award will not be used to determine Champion's Award rankings.

Alliance Team Rounds

3:15 PM

Teams will compete with their three team alliance to see which alliance team gets the highest performance score in a single match. The alliance team that receives the highest score will receive the Robot Alliance Performance Award. This award is an optional award and will not be used to determine Champion's Award rankings.
