1. All formal call-backs will take place in the Nutter Center on Saturday, May 9th.
2. The full formal call-back schedule (including room locations) will be available Friday evening, May 8th from 7:30-9:00PM at the FLL U.S. Open Information Booth in the Student Union. This booth will be located near the Team dinner. Also available at the booth during this time will be event programs, match schedules, and personnel on-hand to answer any questions you might have about Saturday call-back procedures. The schedule will also be available from Pit Administration on Saturday morning, May 9th. Please note that call-backs will begin at 8:30AM on Saturday so please make sure you check the schedule on Friday night or early Saturday morning.
3. You do not need any materials for formal call-backs. Please bring your team only.
4. Informal call-backs will be held in the Pits. You will not receive a specific schedule for these call-backs.
5. Teams in the following Pods should attempt to remain in their Pods for informal call-backs whenever possible (except during your scheduled run) during Round 1 (9:00AM – 10:15AM) on Saturday: Carson, Edison, Resnick, Carver, Flowers.
6. Teams in the following Pods should attempt to remain in their Pods for informal call-backs whenever possible (except during your scheduled run) during Round 2 (10:30AM – 11:45AM) on Saturday: Woods, Curie, Kamen, Wright, Kettering.
7. Your team may also be observed during all phases of robot competition (Practice, Competition, Elimination and Alliance) by judges looking to assess Teamwork, how your robot performs, FLL Core Values and Gracious Professionalism.
8. If your team receives a call-back, you should not necessarily expect to receive an award. Call-backs are done for a multitude of reasons.
9. Call-backs will not be listed for a specific purpose. For example, there will not be Project specific call-backs, or Teamwork specific call-backs, or Robot Design specific call-backs. There will just be call-backs. Your team may get asked for further information on any or all of Project, Robot Design, Teamwork and FLL Core Values during the same call-back.
