


Session Seven: GPS

During session seven, the students used GPS units to locate hidden objects around the school grounds during a Geocache. Geocaching is a world-wide activity where people hide small caches in hopes that other GPS users can find them and then share the coordinates of the object on a website. The students greatly enjoyed this outdoor activity that Rockstar, a STARBASE instructor, organized for them.



In addition to the Geocaching, the students completed the One Body Team Exploration activity. The students traced one of their body parts on a large sheet of paper. Together, all the parts made one body. Through this activity, the mentors reiterated to the students that every person brings their own unique contribution to the group. Because of each special element, the things a group can make together can be very creative and unique as well!



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
